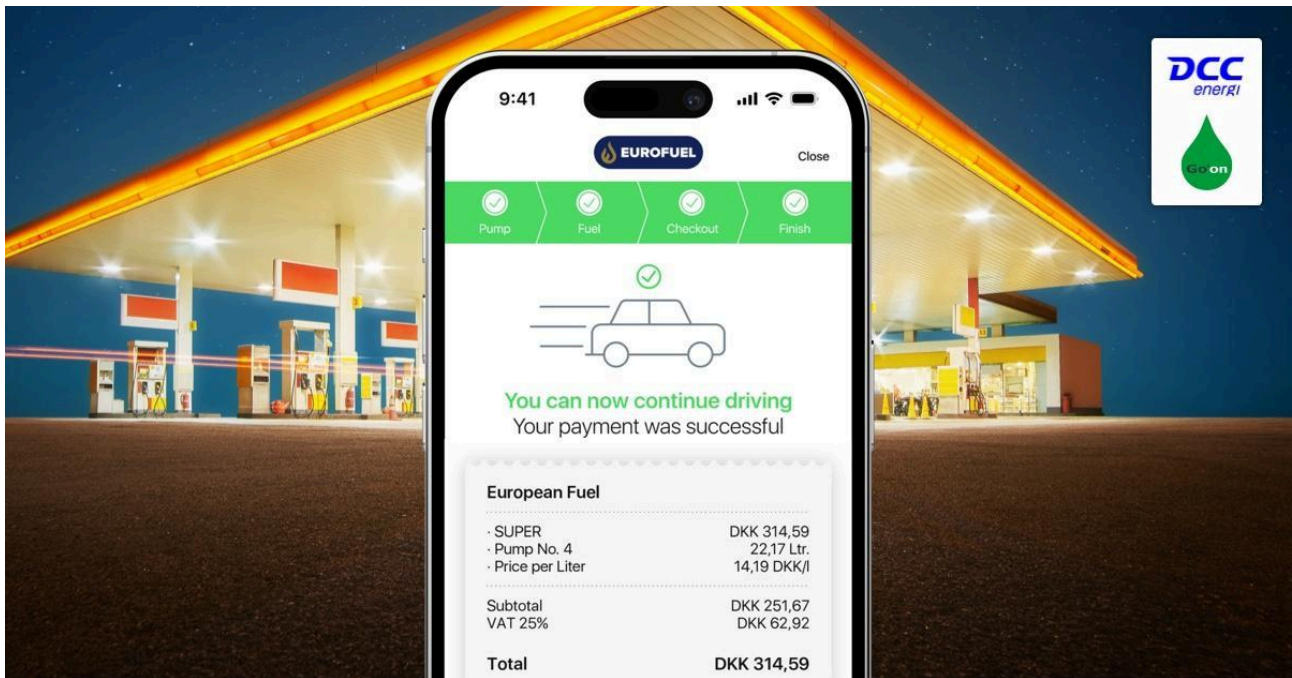


PACE Drives Mobile Payment Forward and Extends its Gas Station Network in Denmark
